



#### **GLO SURVEY HISTORY**

Researching the government survey records for Macomb County shows that the south and east lines of Clinton Township were surveyed and the township was subdivided into sections with closing corners set on the north and west township lines by William Preston, D.S. from 1817-1818.

Private Claim (PC) No. 136 was surveyed by Aaron Greeley, Surveyor of Private Claims on July 18, 1810. The description cites the following: "commencing at an Oak tree standing on the border of River Huron between this tract and a tract confirmed to Christian Clemens and James Connor". The most northeasterly corner of Private Claim No. 136 is described as a Birch tree standing on the east bank of the north branch.

#### **EXISTING FIELD CONDITIONS**

The corner has been perpetuated with a 3/8" x 18" iron pipe that falls in an old fence line extending to the north and south. Also 41 feet  $\pm$  south of the south bank of the Clinton River that is extending in an east and west direction.

By accepting the found 3/8" iron pipe as the corner for the intersection of a common line between the west line of fractional Section 3 and the east line of Private Claim No. 136 with the south bank of the Clinton River. There are three (3) deflection points on this common line listed below.

- 1.) At the intersection of the common line between fractional Sections 3 & 10
- 2.) Point in the east line of property description for Parcel 11-03-458-014.
- 3.) Holding the found ½" iron rod that falls in the existing center line of Dunham Road extending in an east and west direction which has a bituminous surface.

Robert E. Hornyak, PS #44286 recorded a LCRC on April 6, 2010 in Liber 20208, page 553 of Macomb County Records. He found a ½" iron pipe, and cites the same witnesses as those listed on the 2009 unrecorded Certificate of Survey.

#### **SURVEYOR'S RECOMMENDATION**

The witnesses from the above mentioned recorded LCRC and unrecorded Certificate of Survey were used to verify the location of the found 3/8" iron pipe as of October 10, 2014. I am therefore recommending to the Macomb County Survey Peer Group that they accept the found 3/8" iron pipe as the best evidence of the corner position to be perpetuated.




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




# Legend Platted Area Boun Property Line Property Split Line Property Combinee Township Boundar Traverse Line Dimension Extent II









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
