SKETCH OF PRIVATE CLAIM 175



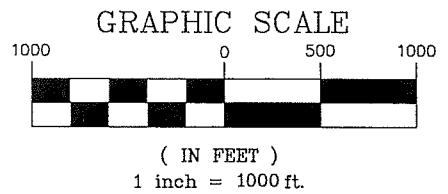
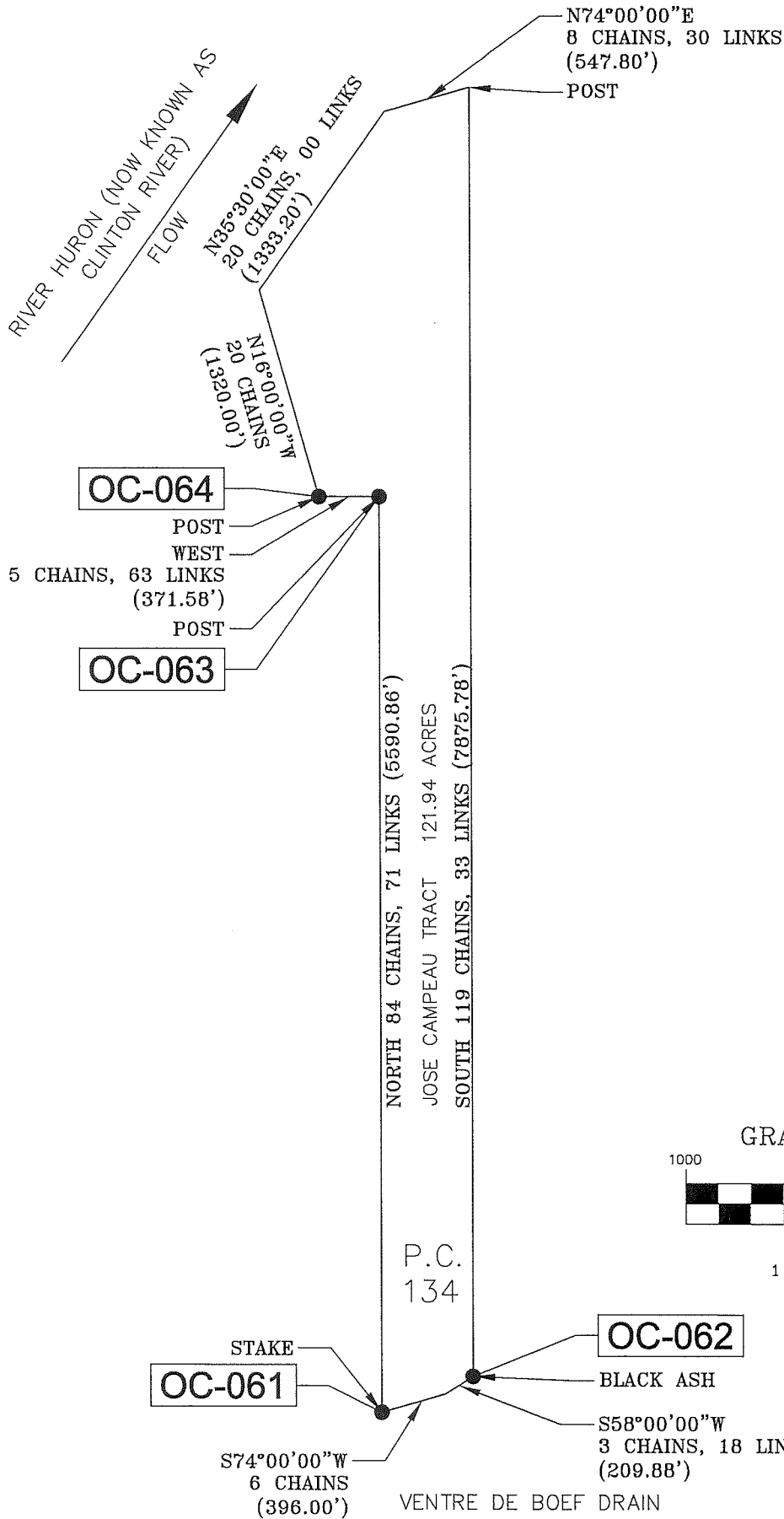
